




Hemp: different models, our favorite crop








	Oilseed hemp	Textile hemp
Sowing	April / May	
Harvest period	September	August
Retting?	Not necessary	Yes, in the field
Seeds yield	≈ 1 Ton per Ha	None
Stalks yield	3 to 5 Tons per Ha	6 to 7,5 Tons per Ha
Dedicated machinery	Not necessary	Preferred




